Pontiac Lake Recreation Area Equestrian Staging Areas and Horseman's Campground are located off Teggerdine Road in beautiful White Lake Township. 3,800 acres of rolling woodland glacial terrain supports a variety of activities at the park. The designated horse trails are open year round and the area habitat is a mixture of marshes, meadows and old hardwood forest that offer equestrians some of the best trail riding in Southeast Michigan and is also the home to the headwaters for the Huron River.

The rustic horse only campground is open May to October and offers 25 rustic sites with a self-registration center, a hand pump and a vault toilet. The day staging area located off Teggerdine Road, between White Lake Road and Pontiac Lake Road is open year round with access to the horse trails.
